1. Discussion Meeting of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (24th July 2023)

The main aim of the discussion at the meeting is to determine how to implement the various social services for the UBA adopted villages like Vagurampatti, Parali, Aniyapuram, Tholur and Pettapalayam in Namakkal District during the months of August & September. Especially, it is decided to execute the people's welfare works such as the availability of the various Central and State Government public welfare schemes, training of online banking transactions through Android mobile phones, free general medical camps, free eye camps, breastfeeding awareness programmes for the married women of these UBA adopted villages, plastic awareness, environmental protection awareness, water management, and so on.

2. Tree Plantation event through the UBA Cell

8. Grama Sabha Meeting, August 15, 2023

On the occasion of Independence Day Celebrations (15.08.2023), Grama Sabha meetings were held in many villages in India. Grama Sabha Meetings were held in the UBA-adopted villages of the college like Vagurampatti, Parali, Aniyapuram, Tholur, and Pettapalayam on August 15, 2023.

- 4. Additional bus facilities are required for the convenience of local people.
- 5. Some of the roads have been damaged due to the recent rain. It should be rectified as early as possible.
- 6. Medicine shortages are highly prevalent in primary health centres. Additional medicines should be procured for the sake of patients in government hospitals.
- 7. The working hours of libraries are very short. Library hours should be extended by an additional hour.
- 8. Grama Sabha meetings should be conducted at least once every two months.

The Presidents, Mr. A. Raja Rahman (Vagurampatti village), Mrs. K. Kuppayee (Pettapalayam), Mr. S. Navaladi (Tholur), Mrs. A. Arukkani (Parali), and Mr. S. Murugesan (Aniyapuram), and the ward members of the Village Panchayat took part.
