1. Tree Plantation Programme

As part of the Swachchata Hi Seva Campaign – 2024, tree plantation programme was held on 19th September 2024 at Tholur village, Mohanur Taluk, Namakkal District. Dr. M. Sasikala and Mrs. V. Gokila, NSS Programme Officers, Trinity College for Women, Namakkal explained about the significance of plantation and has motivated NSS volunteers to plant trees, and water it every day until their growth. Nearly 20 NSS volunteers actively participated in that event.

2. Free Medical Camp

As part of the Swachcha Hi Seva – 2024, The National Service Scheme, Trinity College for Women, Namakkal conducted a one day medical camp on 20th September 2024 in the village of Tholur, Mohanur Taluk, Namakkal District. 104 people benefited from the Tholur and its neighbouring villages Kizh Tholur, Mel Tholur, Nadu Tholur, Sottaiyampudur, Madakasampatti, K. Pudupalayam, Kalipalayam, Ariyur and Nochipatti. Dr. R. Sathya, Medical Practitioner and the supporting staff from Thangam Hospitals and Cancer Centre, Namakkal took part. This medical camp was inaugurated by Mr. P. Balasubramanian, Vice-President and Councillor Ward No 2, Tholur village.

3. Swachch Bharat Diwas Celebration

Our volunteers of National Service Scheme, Trinity College for Women, Namakkal participated in the cleanliness drive organized by the College under the programme “Swachch Bharat Diwas Celebration” on 24th September 2024. The volunteers of NSS cleaned the entire campus and collected all the litter in big bags for disposal. Under the supervision of Dr. M. Sasikala, NSS Programme Officer (Unit 1) and Mrs.V. Gokila, NSS Programme Officer (Unit 2), Trinity College for Women, Namakkal, this event was held.

4. The Swachchata Hi Seva – Cleaning drive

The NSS Cell of Trinity College for Women, Namakkal organized an event on “Swachatta Pledge Taking Ceremony” on 24th September 2024 at the College campus. The “Swachch Bharat Abhiyan” is a massive mass movement that seeks to create a clean India. Mrs. V. Gokila, NSS Programme Officer, Unit 2, Trinity College for Women, Namakkal, read the pledge on Swachch Bharat Mission” to the students of Trinity College for Women, Namakkal, to orient awareness on cleanliness both inside and outside the premises. The pledge was repeated by the all the volunteers of NSS to commit themselves to contribute to the Swachch Bharat Mission.

5. Human Chain Event on Clean India

Malarselvi also took part along with the school students.

9. Seedball throwing campaign – 2024

In part as “Swachchata Hi Seva Campaign – 2024, The National Service Scheme of Trinity College for Women, Namakkal had organized a seedball throwing campaign programme on 30th September 2024. It was held in Siddhar Hills, Vaguramapatti in Namakkal. All the 100 volunteers of the National Service Scheme as well as faculty members of Commerce (Dr. S. Devi, Dr. G. Sathiya Sangari, Mrs. M. Rajapadmavathi, Mrs. A. Rajeswari, Ms. P. Madhupriya and Ms. P. Dhanushiya) have actively participated in that programme. The programme started with preparation of seed balls (seeds including Jamun, Papaya, Neem, Mango and Ashoka) which was further followed by throwing a ball in fertile soil. More than 200 seedballs were prepared by NSS volunteers.

10. Cleaning Programme in Siddhar Hills and its surrounding places

As a component of the Swachatta Hi- Seva campaign 2024, the National Service Scheme of Trinity College for Women, Namakkal conducted a cleaning programme on 01.10.2024 at Siddhar Hills, Near Singilipatti, Namakkal. All the NSS volunteers along with the NSS Programme Officers, Dr. M. Sasikala and Mrs. V. Gokila, they cleaned the various areas of that village. Also, they collected dry and wet waste separately. All the rubbish bags are collected in one place and then dry waste to the dumping area.

Sasikala, Mrs. V.Gokila, the faculty of Computer Science Mrs. S. Priya and Mrs. D. Prabha also took part.
