## INTRODUCING HTML AND XHTML

- HTML stands for Hyper Text Markup Language
- HTML is the standard markup language used for creating Web pages
- There have been several versions of HTML since the Web began, and the development of the language is overseen by an organization called the **W<sub>3</sub>C** (World Wide Web Consortium).
- The First version of HTML was written by Tim Berners Lee in 1993.

- The last major version of HTML was HTML 4.01 in December 1999.
- In January 2000, some stricter rules were added to HTML 4.01, creating what is known as XHTML (Extensible Hypertext Markup Language),
- Wheneveryou write a web page in XHTML, the whole of the page is contained between the opening <html> and closing </html>tags. Inside the<html>element, there are two main parts to the page:<head> element and <body> element.

#### Example Explained

- The <!DOCTYPE html> declaration defines that this document is an HTML5 document
- The <html> element is the root element of an HTML page
- The <head> element contains meta information about the HTML page
- The <title> element specifies a title for the HTML page (which is shown in the browser's title bar or in the page's tab)
- The <body> element defines the document's body, and is a container for all the visible contents, such as headings, paragraphs, images, hyperlinks, tables, lists, etc.
- The <h1> element defines a large heading
- The element defines a paragraph

#### TagsandElements:

- An HTML element is defined by a start tag, some content, and an end tag:
- <tagname> Content goes here... </tagname>
- The HTML element is everything from the start tag to the end tag:
- <h1>My First Heading</h1>
- The opening tag says "This is the beginning of a heading" and the closing tag says "This is the end of aheading."
- My first paragraph.

- The<head>element:Oftenreferredtoastheheadofthepa ge,thiscontainsinformationaboutthe page (this is not the main content of the page).Itconsistsoftheopening<head>tag,theclosing</h ead>tag,andeverything in between.
- **The**<body>**element:**Oftenreferredto as the body of the page, this contains the information you actually see in the main browser window. It consists of the opening < body>tag, closing
- </body>tag,andeverythinginbetween.
